We are delighted to welcome Rabbi/Cantor Marsha Dubrow, Ph.D. as facilitator of our Rosh Chodesh group.

Rabbi Marsha Dubrow, since 2018, has been a Non-Resident Visiting Scholar at the Jewish Theological Seminary in New York City. Rabbi Dubrow received a Ph.D. in Musicology from Princeton University. She is a recipient of a Milstein Fellowship from the Center for Jewish History in New York. From 2005-2017 Rabbi Dubrow served a Conservative congregation in northern New Jersey as both Rabbi and Cantor. Prior to her role as Jewish clergy, Rabbi Dubrow was a corporate executive at AT&T and Founder/CEO of a management and technology consulting firm. A composer of Jewish liturgical music, often with a female text orientation, she was selected by Shalsholet, the Foundation for New Jewish Music, for both public performance and publication multiple times. A member of the Women Cantors Network (WCN), Rabbi Dubrow's music will be featured in the forthcoming Cantors Assembly volume for Shabbat.
